Content of the introductory week


- Academic information (schedules, studies' organization, programs, learning agreements, meetings with faculties' coordinators)

- Practical information: student cards, possibilities to participate in Erasmus exchange (Studies, internships), contacts of manager and coordinators
- Invitation to join MRU Cultural activities

During the first welcome meeting each student receives an info package:






PRESENTATION BY THE COORDIANTOR OF INCOMING STUDENTS

- Leave time for Q&A session


















Socialization trips (Trakal, Kaunas, Druskininkai)
