Science, Technology and International Affairs Department, QBU organized a successful training on International Credit Mobility and International Relations Management for the staff members under the Erasmus+ HARMONY project. The training took place at HARMONY lab, QBU Admisnistration Building on August 30th, 2023.



The training was expected to introduce QBU members the progress and effects of the Harmony projects, and to equip faculty and staff members with the necessary skills and knowledge required for successful international credit mobility and international relations management. The topics presented in the training includes the implemationatin of the Harmony project in the recent time consisting of the achievements and challenges, the introduction to the European Union's Erasmus+ program, some international student and faculty exchanges program that QBU should take into consideratios for action, international partnerships, and strategies for managing international relations.

Dr. Vo Khac Son the Rector of QBU delivered the welcome speech of the training session and expressed the significance of Internationalization at QBU in the long run developments and stability. He also expected the contribution of the staff in terms of developing the professional skills in international partnerships and exchanges.
